Be at Venice Beach by 9:30 am

(Allow about 1 ½ Hour Travel Time)

Directions to Venice Beach

- Take I-75 North to exit 193
- Make a left on Jacoranda Blvd. Stay on Jacoranda for about 1 mile.
- Make a right onto Venice Ave. Stay in the left hand lane.
- Take Venice Ave until it ends at the beach.
- Make a right at the stop sign and a left into the beach parking lot.

The Dive

- Gear up in the parking lot.
- Walk to the water and put your fins on in the water.
- Surface swim using your snorkel to the north swim buoy.
- Follow the buoy chain to the bottom.
- Head west until you hit the reef.
- Find a sandy patch inside the reef. Lay on the bottom let your eyes focus.
- Look for shiny surfaces or straight lines in the sand. Those will be the teeth.
- When you get to 600 psi or 1 ½ hours of bottom time start heading east until you get to 6 feet of water and surface.

Gear Needed

- Basic dive gear (Mask, Fins, Snorkel, Bcd, Reg, Tank, and Weights)
- **Compass (Very Important).**
- Small Mesh Bag to collect sharks teeth in.
